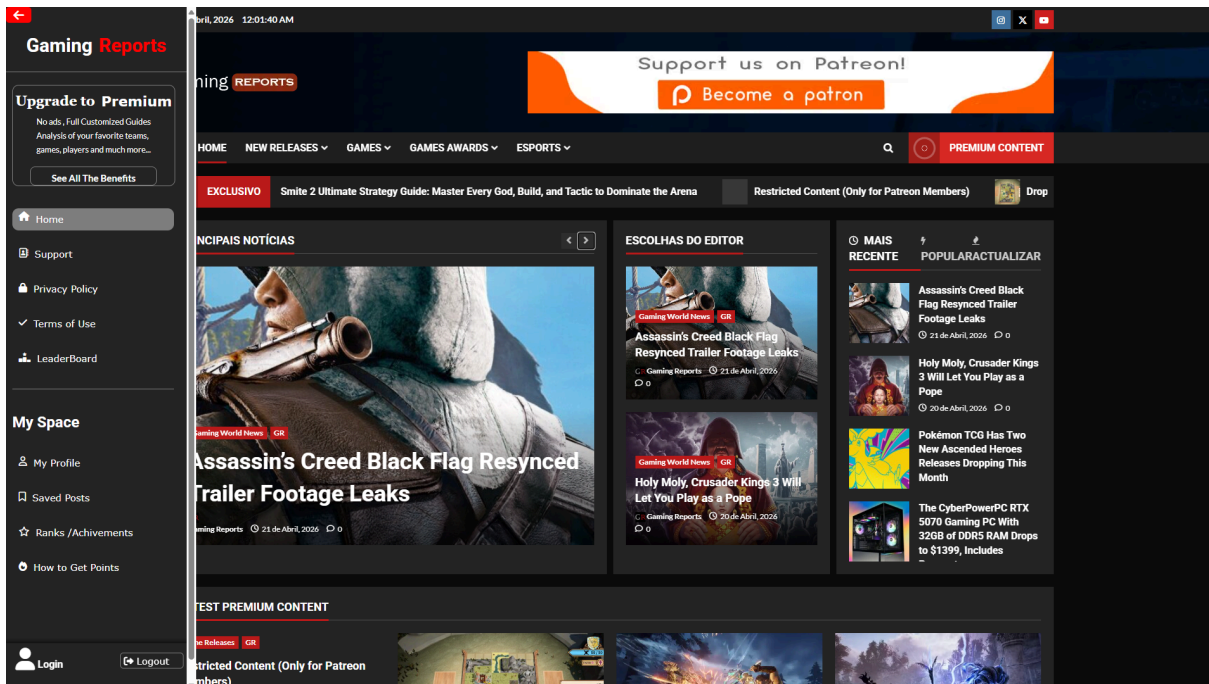
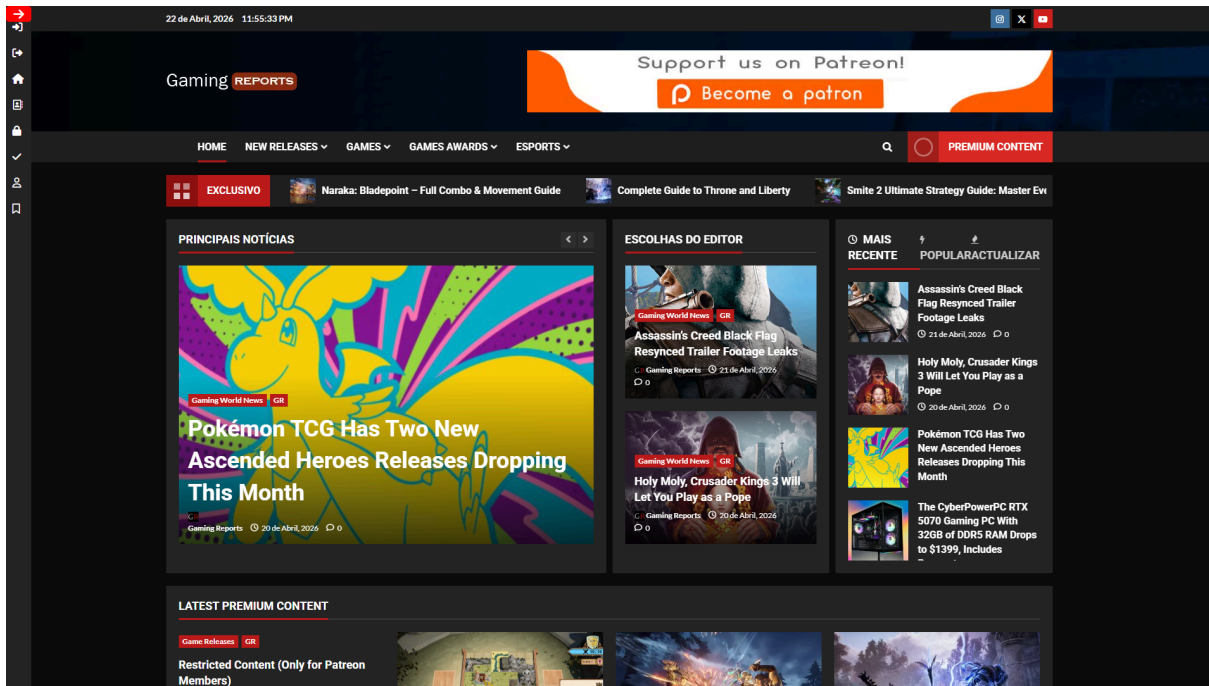


WEBSITE STRUCTURE (PAGES)

Home Page:



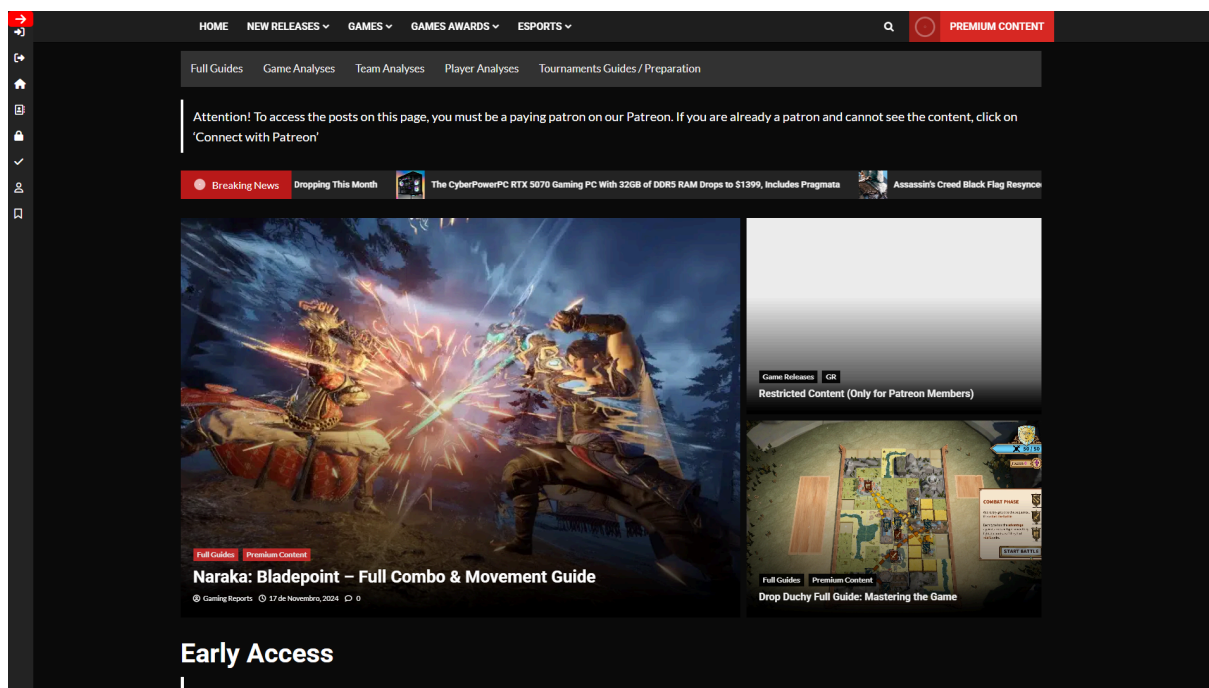
